

# NAMIBIA TRACKS & TRAILS

## **EPUPA- AND OVAHIMBA EXPERIENCE**

**4 days / 3 nights**

**Mobile guided camping safari – Wet Season (January 2009 until March 2009)**

**Due to the annual rains the routing for this safari has to be altered as most of the dry rivers flood, and some roads become impossible. The following Itinerary is an indication of the route which will be followed during the rainy season, but will be subject to change without prior notice, depending on road and weather conditions.**

### Day 1:

Early morning breakfast and departure from the Palmwag Lodge. Head north towards Opuwo, the capital of Kaokoland and Kunene Province. After a brief stop in Opuwo, head further north past the settlement of Okangwati into a picturesque mountain range in the vicinity where camp for the night is erected. Various encounters with local Ovahimba herdsman and their families en route.

Wild camping in the Okangwati area on a full board basis.

### Day 2:

Today the safari reaches its prize destination, the Epupa Falls on the mighty Kunene River, which forms the border between Namibia and Angola. Enough time is spent to explore the majestic falls on an adventurous walk along the falls followed by a welcoming swim in one of the upper rapids of the falls. Camp is pitched on the banks of the Kunene River. Camping on a full board basis.

### Day 3:

After an early morning walk along the falls, pack up camp and drive along the river bank, exploring this fascinating area, Travel meander with the river through mountains and valleys. Wild camping under the tall palm trees growing on the river banks on a Full board basis.

### Day 4:

Pack up camp and head back towards Palmwag Lodge via Opuwo and Sesfontein to Palmwag Lodge. Lunch stop en route with brief visit at the Ongongo waterfall. Late afternoon arrival at the Lodge to settle down for a relaxing sundowner. End of tour.

### INCLUDED:

- Travelling costs as per itinerary; game drives, activities, entrance- and park fees;
- Accommodation in two-man tents / double rooms;
- Full board, refreshment drinks en route, house wine and beer at dinner whilst camping;
- Experienced guiding in English or German;
- VAT and Bed levy.

### EXCLUDED:

- Expenses of a personal nature, i.e. laundry, telephone, gratuities, souvenirs, etc
- Personal-, medical- and evacuation insurances;
- Additional activities
- Alcoholic beverages and drinks

### PLEASE NOTE:

- Rates are as per scheduled departures above;
- For private departures during high season (July – November) a 20% per person of the tour price is applicable;
- For private departures during low season (December – June) the above rates apply;
- It is compulsory for all guests to have comprehensive cancellation-, default-, baggage-, emergency evacuation- and medical insurance for the duration of the trip;
- The operator reserves the right to change the itinerary.

Scheduled departures: every 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesday in a month.

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
