Fly-in Safari

Is time an issue for you? Do you want to see as much as possible of our beautiful country without having to endure exhausting road trips to remote destinations? Or would you like to absorb the endless expanse of Namibia from a bird's eye view? The answer is a tailor-made fly-in safari designed specially for you.

Day 1 and 2:

Departure from Eros Airport, Windhoek, to Sossusvlei Wilderness Camp, erected in a 21 000 hectare private Nature Park. Built on a small rise approximately 20 km from Sesriem, the Camp offers guests an opportunity to enjoy the sparse, but beautiful landscape of southern Namibia. The Camp's nine well-equipped bungalows are designed to create a cozy ambience. Join our guides on a 4x4 morning- or evening expedition into the harsh desert landscape. Let nature's kaleidoscope of colors at Sossusvlei take your breath away to make your stay here an unforgettable experience. You spend two nights at Sossusvlei Wilderness Camp.

Day 3 and 4:

Today's flight will give you an aerial view of the majestic dunes surrounding Sossusvlei. Proceed along the coast (subject to weather conditions) over Conception Bay, Sandwich Harbour and its famous lagoon to Swakopmund. Travel to Walvis Bay by car and enjoy a dolphin cruise followed by a hearty seafood lunch on the beach. Return to Swakopmund Airport, and fly northwards along the Skeleton Coast, across the Huab River to the landing strip of Damaraland Camp, nestling against the northern cliffs of the Huab River. Relax in one of the nine comfortable *en suite* tents. Revive your spirits with a refreshing swim in the small pool, and then take in the scenery from your tent's veranda. Experience a guided 4x4 adventure into the rocky terrain in search of the elusive desert elephant - a highlight of your visit to Damaraland. Two overnight stays in Damaraland Camp.

Day 5 and 6:

Ongava Tented Camp, with two days of intensive game watching, is your next destination. Discover the mysteries of the African bush on foot in Etosha National Park and in the private reserve of the Camp. Your game ranger takes pleasure in trying to show you the diversity of Namibia's fauna. Relax on the veranda of your room and delight in the comings and goings of a variety of game at the floodlit waterhole. You stay at Ongava Tented Camp for two nights.

Day 7:

After a delicious breakfast, enjoy a final safari to the landing strip of Ongava Lodge. Board the plane, sit back and reflect on an unforgettable trip which reaches conclusion on arrival at the capital.

INCLUDED:

- All air transfers and charters as specified in itinerary
- Accommodation on shared basis
