**WILDLIFE IN NAMIBIA**

***Desert Rhino Camp / Ongava Lodge / Lianshulu Lodge - 7 days / 6 nights***

***Day 1 and 2:***

Depart Eros (Windhoek) Airport or Hosea Kutako Airport at approx 09.00 in the morning per private charter to Desert Rhino Camp. Two overnight stays at Desert Rhino Camp. Fully inclusive.

Desert Rhino Camp is a luxury tented mobile camp run in conjunction with the "Save the Rhino Trust" in the Palmwag concession area of the rugged northern Damaraland. The camp offers a fascinating insight into the ecology and conservation of this incredible area, at the same time contributing directly to the Trust and ultimately the sustainability of this vulnerable area and its wildlife.

The area we traverse, whilst tracking Black Rhino and other wildlife is massive, over 450 000 hectares. The camp has large "meru" tents with en-suite facilities. A maximum of 12 guests will have the rare pleasure of exploring this wild and remote area in the company of the dedicated conservationists who host them together with local trackers. Wildlife in the area includes Hartmann's Mountain Zebra, Giraffe, Oryx, Springbok, Ostrich, Desert Adapted Elephant, Lions, Cheetah, Leopard, Spotted and Brown Hyena and the highlight of course, Black Rhino.

***Day 3 and 4:***

Private charter flight from Desert Rhino Camp to Ongava Lodge. Ongava Game Lodge is situated along the southern boundary of Etosha National Park in the privately owned Ongava Game Reserve. Ongava is the ideal place from which to base your activities when visiting Etosha. Accommodation comprises of fourteen air-conditioned brick, rock and thatch chalets, each with en-suite facilities.

Meals are either served in the main dining area under thatch with a view over the camp's water hole, or on the dining deck under the stars. Activities include game drives in open 4x4 vehicles into the Okavuejo area of Etosha where Lion, Elephant, Cheetah, Gemsbok, Springbok and Hartebeest can be seen at many of the water holes in the park. In addition, night drives, hides and walks with armed guides are enjoyed on the private reserve. Ongava has resident White and Black Rhino, giving guests staying at Ongava the opportunity to see both species.

***Day 5 and 6:***

After breakfast depart Ongava for Lianshulu Lodge.

Cradled between the enigmatic Okavango River to the west and the mighty Zambezi River to the east, Lianshulu Lodge nestles beneath a canopy of shadey Jackalberry- and Mangosteen trees, on the banks of the meandering Kwando River. Here, in the heart of the Mudumu National Park, dry Mopane woodlands meet the allure of a fragile Kwando wetland ecosystem. For the visitor to Lianshulu Lodge, which is located on the periphery of Botswana's legendary wildlife reserves, the attraction will be found in a quintessentially African experience, blending exceptional service with superb scenery and a fascinating array of wildlife.

The future of this unique natural heritage will depend on the active involvement of the people who live in the East Caprivi. Lianshulu Lodge has been instrumental in creating new opportunities and actively encourages projects that utilize indigenous products and knowledge on a sustainable basis. The staff and management are concerned about environmental education and promote wildlife conservation in its broadest sense, in order to create direct economic and social benefits to local communities.

Nature drives in the Mudumu National Park are conducted in open 4x4 vehicles. Other activities include guided morning walks in the park, bird watching, boat excursions and sunset cruises on the Kwando River. Optional night drives are offered between May and November. All these activities are conducted by experienced, resident naturalist guides. An optional visit to the Lizauli Traditional Village, a long standing community tourism project, can be arranged.

Although game populations fluctuate through the seasons, many typical savannah species occur in the area - this including buffalo, waterbuck and specials like Roan and Oribi, with Elephant, Zebra and Hippo being particularly abundant.

***Day 7:***

After breakfast, transfer to the airstrip of Lianshulu and subsequent charter to Eros Airport / Hosea Kutako Airport. End of services.

**Desert Rhino Camp / Ongava Lodge / Susuwe Island Lodge - 7 days / 6 nights**

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**Day 1, 2, 3 and 4:**

Itinerary as per PFL B2

**Day 5 and 6:**

After breakfast road transfer to Ongava airstrip - our destination being the Susuwe Island Lodge on the Kwando River. Susuwe Island Lodge offers the opportunity to experience closely a wild and untouched island of Africa. Situated in north eastern Namibia, the island is in the remote Kwando River - a permanent water source which nourishes delicate ecosystems and sustains varied game and birdlife. Relaxation, privacy and comfort are paramount here. Susuwe Island Lodge is built to incorporate the riverine forest - the main complex has lofty canopy viewing decks overlooking endless savannahs, glistening lily-studded wetlands and ancient Kalahari woodlands, as well as a fireplace, spacious lounge and dining areas, curio shop and small reference library. Six spacious brick and thatch suites equipped with double bathroom, bedroom, lounge and wooden viewing deck each with private plunge pool offer guests the opportunity to merge unhurriedly with Africa's timeless evolution of hazy days and star-studded nights. Mosquito nets, overhead fans and hairdryers as well as generated electricity are provided. At Susuwe game drives are being conducted in open 4x4 vehicles in the Bwabwata National Park. Game sightings in this cradle of rivers could include vast herds of roaming elephant and buffalo, lion, hippo, leopard, sable, roan, lechewe and puku for example. Night drives at Susuwe offer an even closer insight into the intrigue of the African bush.

**Day 7:**

After breakfast, return flight to Eros / Hosea Kutako Airport, Windhoek. End of services.

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**Day 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6:**

**Day 7 and 8:**

After breakfast road transfer to Susuwe airstrip - our destination being the Impalila Island Lodge. The peaceful and secluded Impalila River Lodge is situated in Namibia on an island at the confluence of the mighty Zambezi- and Chobe Rivers, at the meeting place of four countries (Namibia, Zimbabwe, Zambia and Botswana). The area is the eastern most tip of the Caprivi Strip - from the air an amazing mosaic of waterways, floodplains and bushveld - on the ground exceptional bird life, game-viewing and assorted vegetation - and, in the waters outstanding fishing opportunities.

The Lodge offers eight private chalets, elevated within lush riverine forest, offering superb views over either the Mambova rapids or quiet backwaters of the Zambezi River. Each chalet is luxuriously appointed with en-suite bathrooms and a choice of either king- or double bed or twin beds, equipped with an overhead fan, hairdryer, mosquito nets and private deck. The main complex facilities include swimming pool, bar, curio shop, reference library, lounge and dining area - this all built under the canopy of an ancient baobab tree.

Guests may choose how they spend their leisure time and apart from the luxurious accommodation and culinary delights, a wide variety of activities are offered. A sunset game cruise on the Chobe River, fly-fishing the Mambova rapids for the rapacious Tigerfish or bream, guided walks on the island including visits to cultural villages and a 2000 year-old baobab tree, from where the meeting of all four countries and two rivers can be witnessed, mokoro (dugout canoe) trips in the quiet backwaters, or just pampered relaxation. Bird watching - some of Africa's rarest birds are spotted here. Day trips to Victoria Falls and scenic flights over the Chobe and Zambezi Rivers, can be arranged.
